4. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION / INFORMATION

4.1 NRLC MURAL FINAL DESIGN

Mrs D Broad entered the meeting at 5.36 pm.

The Community Development Coordinator has received an amended draft mural design (Attachment A) from artist, Jerome Davenport for the mural at the NRLC wall. The amended design is based on the TAC's comments after receiving and accepting Jerome's initial concept design.

The TAC is requested to discuss the amended artwork with artist Jerome via a Teams Meeting, specifically addressing any further requirements to the design, prior to recommendation to Council as the final design. This is also an opportunity for the artist to bed down the final design and ask any outstanding questions of the TAC that remain.

The supplied timeline (Attachment B) is attached for information.

OFFICER RECOMMENDATION

That the Townscape Advisory Committee recommend to the Council that artist Jerome Davenport be the successful designer for the proposed Narrogin Regional Leisure Centre Mural, at a total fixed sum of \$106,140.00 excluding GST and in accordance with the principles of the submitted and approved design.

After discussion with the TAC and the Artist Jerome it was recommended by the TAC for the Artist to make further amendments to the concept design prior to recommending the final version to Council.

Comments as follows re changes:

- Move farmer to the right.
- Indigenous design to be in top left corner instead of trees, indigenous art to be done by indigenous artist by Jerome and included in the existing quote. Mrs V Chadwick supplied a potential indigenous theme design to Jerome that could be modelled on.
- One of the fire fighters in the bottom left could be female.
- One of the footy players to be indigenous.

Once these modifications are complete including the indigenous art, the final design is to be presented to the TAC for final comment prior to recommendation to Council.
